Midtown Farmers Market Opens Saturday

BRYANT (April 30, 2009) – Midtown, the unique mixed-use neighborhood development being built north of Highway 5 in Bryant, opens its Farmers Market this Saturday, May 2nd at the developments Market Square pavilions.

The Midtown Farmers Market will be open every Saturday throughout the summer months from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The Midtown concept advocates a return to a more traditional neighborhood with pedestrian friendly streets, squares, parks and small-town amenities like the Farmers Market.

According to Jones, Midtown is a neighborhood that will energize the entire city of Bryant.

“The Farmers Market is just one of many activities that we have planned for the new Midtown. I’m sure folks remember the Christmas party we hosted last December that was such a huge success. We will continue to plan exciting events throughout the year to enhance the quality of life in Bryant,” explained Jones.

Construction of Midtown continues with a variety of homes being built on the 190-acre site. Visitors to Saturday’s Farmers Market are invited to tour the neighborhood.
